Inspired in the 1950's by the collection of nickelodeon pianos at Angelo Valente's "House of Nickelodeons", the Sanfilippo music machine collection was started in 1978 with a small Nelson-Wiggen coin piano, a Bruder band organ, and a Welte Concert Orchestrion. It has since expanded and now houses: the 1927 Wurlitzer world's largest theater pipe organ; the Eden Palais Carouel, which was built in 1890 and is fully restored and operational; and an 1881 Grant Railroad Locomotive, used by Henry Ford. You will also view rare slot machines, Tiffany glass lamps, spectacular street clocks, coin pianos, and many more antiques. Visit their website for a full list!
