

IL DCEO REBUILD PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE APPLICATION
PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES- JUNE 18, 2020- 7:30 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER:

The public hearing meeting was called to order by the Village Clerk at 7:30 P.M.

PROJECT PRESENTATION:

Mr. Chastain gave an overview of the DCEO Rebuild Illinois grants that will be submitted to the Department by Tuesday, June 30th, as well as the purpose of the Public Hearing. He stated that according to the grant program requirements, residents and stakeholders must have the opportunity to ask questions and address concerns if the Village is using municipal funds to match any of these grants. In this case, the Village will have matching local funds for two (2) of the three (3) applications submitted.

PROJECT #1-RIVERCREST DRIVE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Project #1 is a request for \$1,165,510.00 in Rebuild Illinois funds under the Public Infrastructure Grant Program to resurface Rivercrest Drive from Cicero Avenue to Cal-Sag Road. This is the major roadway that traverses the Village's major retail center, Rivercrest Center. Funds from the State would be used for the engineering design of the project which will also address the funding priorities relative to flood and drainage, water, and sewer - as stated in the Competitive Public Infrastructure guidebook of the REBUILD program. The project involves the resurfacing of approximately 22,000 Square yards of asphalt pavement to include spot repair of existing curb and gutter; adjustment of inlets; pavement patches and miscellaneous parkway restoration. This application will seek to have Illinois fund 80% (\$932,408.00) of the projected project costs, with \$233,102.00 or 20% to be paid for with Village MFT funds. No persons will be displaced for this project

PROJECT #2-MUNICIPAL COMPLEX PARKING LOT EXPANSION

Project #2 is a request for \$774,235.00 in Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure funds to expand the parking lot at the Municipal Complex where the Village Hall, the new Civic Center, the Police HQ and the Fire House are situated. The Village is currently negotiating with a residential property owner next to the complex to acquire the residence, demolish the house and expand the lot to meet future parking and first-responder needs. The funds will only pay for additional asphalt, resurfacing the existing lot, enhancing storm drainage collection and re-striping the lot. The village will match the grant funds at 20% or \$154,847.00 with 80% or \$619,388.00 from the State. No persons will be displaced for this project.

PROJECT #3-CAL-SAG EAST DEVELOPMENT

Project #3 is a request to the DCEO for the Rebuild Illinois "Shovel Ready" site program for preliminary engineering, site planning and geotechnical and environmental studies for the site known as Cal-Sag East, a 45 acre site along Cal-Sag Road and the Cal-Sag Channel. However, the Village is seeking the State to cover 100% of the \$266,000.00 grant request. Since there are no local funds involved in this request, it is not a subject of this Public Hearing. No persons will be displaced for this project.

OPEN FORUM/QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

There were no questions from the Mayor or the Board of Trustees.

There being no further questions to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
