- Had monthly safety meeting and completed safety videos.
- Cleaned up PW garage bays
- Worked on 2 fire hydrant
- Cleaned floors and removed garbage at new Civic Center.

- Cleaned floors and removed garbage at Village Hall.
- Cleaned Public Works trucks and backhoes.
- Repaired 1 b-boxes
- Repaired 3 storm water inlet
- Repaired 4 sanitary sewer manholes.
- Worked on 7 restorations throughout the Village.
- Cut and weed wacked grass at parks and village properties

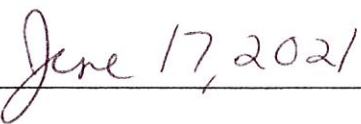
