Trustee Wasag read the Crestwood Recreation and Wellness Center Report for the month of February, 2021 as submitted by Rocco Mossuto highlighting the following information.

They are very excited to be open and serving the community. We are following the CDC guidelines. The following highlights were listed:

1. We started hosting indoor practices for Crestwood Crush baseball and Crestwood Fast pitch softball in January and will continue until March.
2. The next spring session of swim lessons will begin the week of March 2nd.
3. The CRWC is happy to present our first ever Dodgeball League starting on February 5th.
4. We will be continuing both our Monday and Thursday Yoga classes throughout the winter. New session times and dates will be announced by the end of February.
5. Wednesday nights in February we will continue to host drop in pickle ball from 7-10 p.m. at the CRWC. All-inclusive members play for free for all others the drop in fee is \$5.00 per session.
6. We still have youth practices daily at the CRWC. This month marked the beginning of our partnership with Jaguar Basketball. They join our list of 17 partners in youth sports at the CRWC. We will continue to do our very best to keep our community on the move during these trying times.

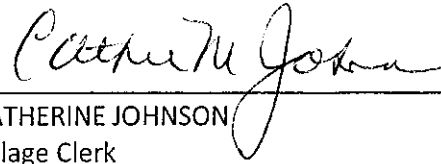

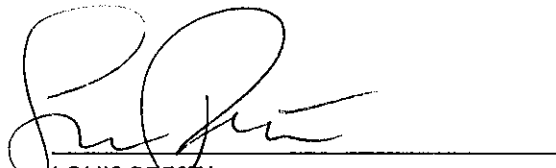

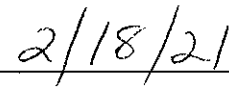
