3. Tony's Fresh Market took over the building at 4925 Cal Sag Rd. last Friday and is hoping to open December, 2024.
4. A development company has plans to purchase the property at 141st to 142nd and Pulaski Rd. and develop a large fuel station with convenience store and possible small stores or Restaurants.
5. Southwest Conference of Mayor's has a dinner meeting on May 22nd that the Mayor will not be able to attend, if any of the Trustees would like to.

6. The problem at the dike on 135th and Central is continuing with the MWRD and Forest Preserve not letting us make the repairs needed without additional charges.
We are still pressing to get it done.
7. The 127th St. bridge, just East of the Cal Sag Rd. intersection is on hold right now for the repairs because the Army Corps of engineers did not like some of the repairs already done on the underside of the bridge last year.
8. The streetscape on Cicero Ave. is moving along slowly, they will be cleaning, patching, and re-striping Cicero Ave.
9. We have received a few applications for Police Chief.
10. There is a bill in congress for safety and immunity which does not appear to be supported.
11. A recurring problem on Le Claire between 132nd St. and 133rd St. where the condo is not cutting the grass adjacent to their buildings.
12. Still some problems with Give to Get on 142nd and Pulaski, with the semis running and just a lot of traffic in general.
13. Mayor keeps reaching out to our representative's with not much help or response.
14. Painting of the fire hydrants is on the summer list.
15. There is a problem manhole behind the gas station on Pulaski Rd.
