STREETS, LIGHTS & DRAINAGE REPORT DATED, JUNE 4, 2026

The Streets, Lights, & Drainage bi-monthly report dated, June 4, 2026 was read by Trustee Skala, highlighting the following work for the last several weeks:

DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES:

Vehicle & Building Maintenance

- Maintained all Police, Fire, EMA and Public Works vehicles
- Maintained all Village buildings and emptied exterior garbage cans
- Cleaned and organized the Public Works building and yard.
- Cleaned Public Works trucks, backhoes, and related equipment
- Greased and cleaned salt trucks and equipment

- Maintained all lawn equipment.

Streetlights, Streets & Stormwater

- Repaired or serviced 13 streetlights throughout the Village
- Performed cleanup work on Cal Sag,
- Checked storm sewers Village wide
- Conducted daily inspections of storm drainage outfalls
- Jetted and cleaned 2 storm sewers
- Repaired 8 stormwater inlets
- Cleaned 24 stormwater catch basins
- Performed pothole and street repairs throughout the Village
- Completed 62 JULIE locate requests
- Ran street sweeper on Eastside of town and Cal-Sag Rd.

Water & Sewer System Work

- Cleaned 7 sanitary sewers
- Worked on 1 fire hydrants and 21 valves
- Serviced and exercised 12 b-boxes.
- Repaired 3 sanitary sewer manhole
- Investigated 2 residential leak reports
- Repaired 1 water main break
- Laser stripped fire hydrants, primed and painted
- Installing 90 feet 4 inch water main

- Assisted with meter reading
- Held the monthly safety meeting and completed safety training videos
- Maintained all grass areas throughout the Village
- Picked weeds at Village Hall complex and Biela Center
- Install siding and painting new game center at Ozinga Stadium

- Worked on grill and play area on new deck at Ozinga Stadium
- Hauled 9 loads of dirt to the dump
- Installed drywall and drop ceiling at PW and 911 Center
- Cleaned up PW yard
- Installed insulation at dispatch center and PW building
- Worked on underground storm sewer at new PW building
- Picked up trash on Cal Sag Rd.

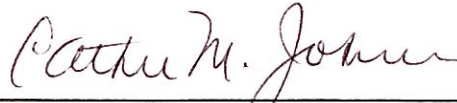
