From **August 14 through September 8, 2026**, Crestwood Police officers will be out looking for traffic violators as part of the Labor Day Traffic Safety Campaign. Motorists should expect an **increased police presence** throughout the campaign period.

Officers will place special emphasis on **impaired driving, speeding, distracted driving and seat belt violations** to help keep Crestwood roadways safe during the Labor Day travel period.

DRIVE SOBER OR GET PULLED OVER

Before you celebrate:

- Designate a sober driver before drinking.
- Never drive after consuming alcohol, cannabis or any other impairing substance.
- Use a rideshare, taxi or other safe transportation if you are impaired.
- Make sure everyone in your vehicle is properly buckled.
- Put the phone down and keep your attention on the road.
- Obey posted speed limits and allow extra time to reach your destination.
- Never allow a friend or family member who is impaired to drive.
